IRIDESCENT AND INTERFERENCE ACRYLIC COLORS

Iridescent Acrylics are a series of colors that have the appearance of metals but not all are true metals. Gold, Bronze, Silver and Copper are made to look like metals, but are actually minute slivers of naturally occurring mica coated with iron oxides. Micaceous Iron Oxide and Stainless Steel are true metals. They are beautiful alone, but added to other pigments, the color shifts are endless.
